Thank you for your enquiry regarding the upcoming Section Player Violin auditions with the New Zealand Symphony Orchestra.

Important Dates:

- **Applications close: Monday 6<sup>th</sup> September, 2010.**
- **Audition date: Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2010.**
- **Location: Wellington, New Zealand**

You will be advised on arrival at the audition which excerpts will be required.  
Accompanists will not be required and there will not be a piano provided.

If you are unable to travel to Wellington for the audition, you may submit an audition recording. The format must be either: CD, mini disk, or DAT tape (which should be indexed). We strongly recommend using a studio to record your audition.

Recording checklist:

- Applications close: Monday 6<sup>th</sup> September, 2010.**
- Recordings Due: Friday 10<sup>th</sup> September, 2010.**
- All audition recordings are unaccompanied.
- All the pieces listed on the requirement sheet have been recorded – solo work first.
- All pieces have been presented unedited. .
- A signed statement from your recording engineer or witness stating that your recording is unedited.
- All excerpts are on a separate track.
- A track list is included.

Only recordings that follow the audition requirements will be accepted. Recordings will only be returned at your request.

The successful candidate/s will be invited to play for a trial period with the orchestra. You will be notified of the results soon after the audition date.
